Yes, Seniors 65 or older with Medicare Parts A & B have a sharing option starting at just \$70 per month.		
Yes, up to \$5,000 of final expenses may be eligible for sharing.		
Yes, for no additional cost, members have \$0 cost, 24/7 access to doctors via telemedicine and a discount program for dental and vision needs.
